Building on your IT Infrastructure Project 1:

## 1. Briefly review the high points of the presentation

## 2. Discuss Technical Considerations

The platforms used for IT Infrastructure Project 1 are considered cloud providers. What type of cloud service and cloud deployments do they offer?

Thinking about an organization in the industry, sketch out the wired and wireless overlay network at the LAN level integrating the infrastructure of the platform and walk the viewer through the sketch.

## 3. Discuss Financial Considerations

Considering "averages" what are some specific cost considerations? As close as you can get, compare and contrast costs with the platform and without it. In other words, what does the business case look like.

\*Hint consider the business processes.

\*Considering using the TCO formula as a metric.

What is the cost of the technical expertise required? What are the specific titles/certification paths that maybe necessary and their costs and time commitments?

What happens if there is a sudden increase in usage/traffic? What happens if usage/traffic suddenly decreases and an organizations is only using a portion of the capacity that the signed up for?

## 4. Discuss Risk Management Considerations

What are some known laws and regulations applicable to the industry?

Who owns the data and infrastructure? Who has access to the data and infrastructure?

What are expected uptimes and downtimes

What does a business continuity plan look like? How would an organization continue on or plan for risk management in the case of disruptions?

How does the platform assist? Do you need to sign up for a particular service or level?

## 5. Other Considerations

Cite appropriate sources as relevant.
